PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

He has accumulated 40 years of experience of development cooperation. Since the 1980s he has worked as an expert at the Italian Agency for Development Cooperation. He was Director of the main Italian Cooperation offices abroad, in Mozambique, Zimbabwe and Malawi, Ethiopia and South Sudan, Lebanon and Syria, Kenya and East African countries (Uganda, Tanzania, Democratic Republic of Congo, Rwanda , Burundi). For several years he coordinated the humanitarian aid of the Italian cooperation.
